Breakfast Club 7.45am new start time!

Breakfast and Afterschool times and costs for 2019/2020

We have reviewed our before and afterschool club care. Following requests from parents we have extended our Breakfast Club to start now at 7.45am. With the extension we made recently to Afterschool club that now means that we can provide care from 7.45am to 5.30pm every day.

We have also reluctantly had to review our costs. We have to increase the cost of both Breakfast and After School club by 50p. This makes Breakfast Club £3.50 a day and After School Club £6.50. The increase in cost is not linked to the increase in time this is a decision we would have had to make anyway.

All bookings for both clubs can be done with the school office.
