Changes to reading

As a school we have decided to make some changes to the reading children do at home. We have invested money in new books which we hope will help the children more and will help you as parents support your children better when they read with you.

The books that we send home will now more closely align with the reading books the children use in school. They will also match the colours we use in school. So in the future if a child is reading a purple school book they will also be taking home a purple reading book.

The books at the early levels will now be what we call phonetically decodable. That means that the majority of words the children come across in the books will have sounds that the children already know. The new books will also have instructions at the front of the book explaining to parents which words you need to talk to your child about before starting the book as well as strategies for breaking longer words down. This is exactly what the children do in school and will support their in school learning well.

To make these changes we will not be sending home any books the week of the **9th November**, children can use Bug Club this week. By Friday 13th November we hope that all children will have a new book with a new colour band. The new colours do not link to the old colours at all so do not worry that your child has been moved back.

We will be sending home some colour bookmarks to help you and your child remember their new colour.

Cold weather and extra clothes

One of the measures we have in place at the moment is ensuring we have good ventilation in all classrooms. This means that we need to keep the windows and doors open.
