We will be cooking some delicious food from around the world and exploring it using our senses.

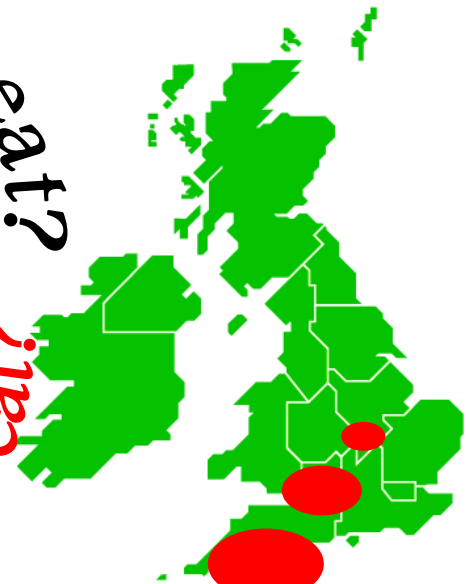


What do you like to eat?
