School Attendance

School attendance has recently been back in the news following the Supreme Courts decision on what constituted regular attendance. A parent of a child on the Isle of Wight had challenged the fine he had received for taking his daughter on holiday. The Supreme Court has decided that it is up to the school and the Local Authority to make a decision on what is regular attendance.

In Hampshire the rules are if you take your child out for five days, within a fifty day period you will be fined. The days do not have to be consecutive days. Illness does not count neither do medical appointments. If you have a genuine family emergency which would mean your child missing school please speak to us as soon as possible and we can work with you and potentially avoid any fines. If you take your child out for even a day in a week where there is national testing, such as the phonics test week or the SATs week then you will also be fined. The fines are £60 per parent, per child. You will only be fined once, after that, even if it is in a different academic year, you could face court proceedings.

As a school we have decided that we will withhold informing Hampshire about fines for parents taking holiday before September, or for parents who have already applied for holiday. If you have booked a holiday between now and the end of term please let us know, and you will not be fined. Any applications for holiday next academic year could now incur a fine.

Fining is something the school does not want to do but we know that good attendance does lead to better academic outcomes for children. High attendance also means children are more confident and happier at school.

The school has to follow the rules set down by Hampshire and we have no flexibility. Any holiday of five days or more, or any holiday that adds up over a period of time to five or more days will be fined.
