Uniform

Thank you for your response to the uniform questionnaire. We had an amazing response from parents.

Earrings

The feedback was extremely conclusive with 93% of parents saying only studs should be worn. This follows the schools current policy and we will ask parents to only put studs in their children's ears.

Hair accessories

On this question the feedback was evenly split. We will therefore not insist on hair accessories being in school colours but recommend that they are. We will ask children to remove any headbands which are not flat and request children limit hair bows to small ones only.
