



Reading

Your child will have a reading book and a reading diary from their previous class.

They can change their book each morning when they come into school. Each class has a day when there will be an adult to help them choose.

On the front of their reading diary will be a coloured sticker, this tells your child which coloured book box they should choose their book from.

If you could record in the diary each time you hear your child read it will ensure that your child moves up and their achievements get recognised. They will move up on the class reading rockets for every 10 times they read, which should take about two weeks.

When your child finishes their reading diary they will then stand up in Celebration Assembly.

They will also stand up in Celebration Assembly when they have read 100 or 200 times.


Kangaroo class change their books with an adult supervising on a **Monday**.

The School Day

Please provide your child with a named water bottle every day. They will bring it home each day. We give every child a piece of fruit in the afternoon but if you would like to send them in with some fruit for morning playtime please do so.



Uniform

Please rename everything after every half term. Please also ensure children are wearing black shoes, no boots for girls as they cannot sit in them. We recommend that hair accessories are in school colours and any headbands are flat.

Toys

We have a no toy policy in school but if your child has something to show us that is linked to any work we are doing in school we would love to see it.

Celebration Assembly

We have a special celebration assembly every Friday at 9:10am. If your child has had their birthday that week or if they have been given a star learner badge they will be standing up. We will also let you know if they will be standing up for any other reasons by writing their name on the celebration sign near the class door.

Parents are always welcome to any Celebration assembly.

PE

Please ensure your child has a PE kit in school every day. They will bring this kit home at the end of every half term.

If your child wears stud earrings please take them out on the day they do PE. Also if your child has long hair please ensure that it is tied up and away from their face.
