Science Week 10th to 14th February and Superhero Dressing Up Day

In two weeks time we will once again be holding our annual Science Week.

Science Week is a week in the school year when we suspend the majority of the normal lessons in school and we completely focus on Science and Technology. The idea of the week is to inspire children in science. We want them to ask questions and wonder about the world around them.

During the week the children will be learning a whole range of different things, from what happens to food when you heat it to experiments with colour. The Year 2 children will be getting a special demonstration from the Science staff from Oakmoor School who have kindly given up a morning to come into school and show us some of the amazing science that goes on there.

On the Tuesday of Science Week we will be having our online safety day. E-Safety day is when we think about how to stay safe online. The children will start to learn the very important message of how to keep themselves safe when using electronic devices online. We will also explore how to follow the same standards of behaviour we have when in school as you do when you are online. With more and more access to online gadgets in our homes we believe this is a very important message to teach.

China Wuhan illness NHS advise

Schools have been asked to pass on advice from the NHS to anyone who has been to Wuhan in China in the last 14 days.

If you have been to Wuhan you are asked to stay indoors, avoid contact with other people and to contact NHS 111 even if you have no symptoms. You are also asked not to go to work or any other public places.

We have no information that any of our families have travelled to China recently we are just passing on information we have been asked to.
