School lunches



The School Day

The school day starts at 8:40 am and finishes at 3:15pm. The class teachers will open the door at 8:40 am and the children will be welcomed into their classrooms. At the end of the day please wait on the playground and the teachers will send your child to you when they can see you.

Picking up

If it is not going to be you picking up your child please tell the teacher if possible in the morning and they will write it in the diary by our class door. If you forget or there is a sudden change of plans just give the school office a ring and they will let us know.

Wellies and Outside Play

We like to be prepared for every type of weather. We also have Forest Time once a week in our school grounds. Please can you leave a named pair of wellies in school.

Fruit and water

Please provide your child with a piece of fruit and a water bottle each morning. Please name any bottles and containers. We also provide a free piece of fruit in the afternoons and milk for all children under 5.

Toys

We have a no toy policy in school however the children will be given opportunities through the year to bring in items from home to show and tell.

Reading

Your child will have a reading book and a reading diary. We will also give them access to our online book system called Bug Club.

We use a system of Reading Rockets in the class. The children have their names on a label and we will move them up on the class reading rockets for every 10 days that they read, which should take about two weeks. If you could record in the diary each day you hear your child read it will ensure that your child moves up and their achievement gets recognised.

Reading diaries will be checked every Friday and your child will stand up the following Friday if they have reached 100 reads.

Your child will have a sticker on the front of their reading diary to show which colour band they are on. Please ensure your child is taking home the correct colour levelled book.

Uniform

Please name everything and rename after every half term. Please also ensure children are wearing black shoes, no boots for girls in winter as they cannot sit in them. We recommend that hair accessories are in school colours and any headbands are flat. One pair of small ear studs are acceptable, other jewellery is not.

PE

Penguins class **PE day is Monday**. Please leave their PE kits at school and we will send them home each half term holiday for washing unless it needs it more often. Please can you put spare knickers/pants and socks in your child's PE bag too in case of an emergency. On Monday's please ensure earrings are removed, long hair is tied up and your child is wearing school uniform they can **independently** remove and put back on.
